3. Two brief letters of recommendation from your high school teachers or counselors.

Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, fees, and on-campus room and board or for other items required by your college or university. If you are selected to receive a scholarship, you will be provided with instructions and a disbursement form to claim your scholarship. Disbursements will be made from MEF directly to the school named in the disbursement form. In some cases, these funds may be considered by the Internal Revenue Service as taxable income. Please consult your tax advisor. If funds are not used by August 31, 2026, scholarship funds may be revoked.
